Site Selection Updates

You've been waiting patiently, and we now have information for you!

Saturday, August 6 is the big day. Voting will open, and we'll be hosting a virtual Q&A.

This year, the membership of Chicon 8 will be able to select the location of both the 2024 Worldcon and the 2023 NASFiC. We accepted bid filings from one Worldcon bid, <u>Glasgow in</u> 2024, and two NASFiC bids, <u>Winnipeg 2023</u> and <u>Orlando in 2023</u>. The bids' formal filings and FAQs can be found on the <u>Chicon 8 website</u>.

We want to give you all an opportunity to learn more about these bidders as you prepare to vote, and to that end, we are hosting a Q&A session with the bidders over Zoom on Saturday, August 6th, at 12:00 PM, CST (8:00 PM EEST, 6:00 PM BST, 1:00 PM EDT, 10:00 AM PDT).

Representatives from the bids will be present to give a short presentation on their bid and then answer questions submitted by our membership. We encourage you to submit your questions in advance to siteselection@chicon.org, though we will also take additional questions by private message during the Zoom meeting. We will likely need to combine some questions due to their similarity, and we will not ask questions which are abusive or violate Chicon 8's <u>Code of</u> <u>Conduct</u>, but we will attempt to ask as many of the questions submitted as possible.

After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing information about joining the meeting.

During the Q&A session, we will begin with five minutes for each NASFiC bid to make a brief presentation, followed by twenty minutes for questions for the bids. We will then have five minutes for our Worldcon bidder to make a brief presentation, followed by twenty minutes for questions. We will close the session with a brief explanation of how to vote in site selection, including electronic voting online through Election Buddy.

Electronic/online voting is a new option, alongside paper voting, this year. After extensive research and trialing we've chosen to go with ElectionBuddy - <u>https://electionbuddy.com/</u> - for this service. We are confident that their service will enable people to vote in a secure and auditable fashion for our Worldcon & NASFiC bids. In addition to an explanation at the Q&A session on the 6th, we'll also be providing documentation online for all our members.
