Alert: Online / Electronic Harassment

We are aware that several members of our community, including panelists and staff, have been victims of online harassment. We are also aware of recent incidents at conventions where attendees and staff were harassed by people impersonating members of the community.

Should you be the victim of this type of harassment, which typically includes texts or emails containing several offensive slurs, please report them to us in whatever way works best for you.

Fringe Events (On site in Chicago)

We have now published our list of Chicon 8 Fringe Events!

We have pre-con and post-con events in addition to things happening off site during the convention. Please note that some of these events will require additional fees, such as museums and tours.

For some of the tours, like the Chicago Architecture Foundation tours, you can purchase tickets ahead of time either online through Ticketmaster (with additional fees), or you can go to the Chicago Architecture Foundation when you arrive downtown and buy them in person. You can also buy them on the day when we get to the dock, but there is always a chance that they won't be available. Details on the website.

Many items will be "captained", meaning that people will gather in the Hyatt lobby and walk to the event together. There are other items, however, where you will have to provide your own transportation, and we've put that in the event detail.

We have some great events - there is a Happy Hour sponsored by Seattle in 2025 Worldcon Bid, several off-site readings, architecture walking and boat tours, trips to the American Writers Museum for the final weekend of their Ray Bradbury exhibit, a trip to Maggie Daley Park for families and kids, and of course, the ever popular Worldcon tradition of "Stroll With The Stars".
