



IT'S EASY BEING GREEN!



Inspired by Chicago's local Capricon convention (see *https://capricon.org/capricon40/capricon30/Greening.php*), Chicon 8 is committed to being an environmentally responsible Worldcon, and we encourage you to join us in our efforts.

What Are We Doing?

Our biggest environmental initiative is to move to all-electronic Progress Reports and an all-electronic Pocket Program. The Souvenir Book will also be available electronically (on an optin basis for attending members, and an opt-out basis for supporters and virtual members).

At the convention, we will also have an all-electronic newsletter, and we're significantly reducing the amount of paper needed for the WSFS Business Meeting.

Taken together, these measures alone save an astonishing 700,000 sheets of paper! And that's not counting the carbon cost of the physical mailings that would usually be required for the Progress Reports and for mailing out Souvenir Books to supporters.

Encouraged by Covid-19, we've also minimized our site visits and pre-con meetings, holding just a single all-staff event prior to the convention. This has resulted in significant savings in air and road miles.

Our partners at the Hyatt Regency Chicago are also doing their part, with initiatives ranging from responsible food sourcing to refillable water stations and banning products with microplastic beads. Excess edible food and gently used bathroom amenities are donated locally, and sensor lighting is used in meeting rooms.

How Can I Help?

Attending members can help us in many ways:

- Carpooling if you're driving to the convention (our Facebook group can be used to find sharers).
- Consider using public transport taking the Blue Line from O'Hare to within a few blocks of the Hyatt Regency costs \$5 just 10% of a taxi/Uber fare, and better for the environment.
- Instead of using disposable cups during the weekend, bring your own reuseable water bottle or coffee mug.
- Bring your own bag for use in the Dealers Room.
- Take advantage of Hyatt options for instance you can opt out of daily housekeeping, greatly reducing water and electricity usage for laundry.

You can also purchase a carbon offset for your attendance. You can find out more about this on our website.

Con Suites — West Tower Concourse (Bronze) Level

These adjoining suites are available for food and socializing from 8 a.m. to midnight (or later) during the main days of the convention.

Toronto

Toronto is a social area. Masks are required and no food is allowed. This is an open area which will be available 24 hours except when closed for cleaning.

Hong Kong

Lite snacks are served in Hong Kong for consumption in Acapulco, which will function as a contained dining area. Masks are required. Snacks are available as grab and go.

Acapulco

Masks may be removed to eat once you are seated in Acapulco. Members may consume snacks from Hong Kong or bring their own food to this area.

Accessibility (Including Wheelchair, Scooter, Assistive Device Rentals)

Chicon 8 is partnering with *Scootaround* to offer a range of assistive devices for rental during the convention. Available devices include powerchairs, power wheelchairs, manual wheelchairs, rollators, oxygen, and in-room medical devices. All rentals must be made in advance using the reservation process detailed in the "Wheelchair, scooter, and other assistive device rental" section of the Accessibility Services guide page on our website:

Childcare

Chicon 8 is happy to partner with *KiddieCorp* to provide professional childcare for children ages 6 months through 12 years old. KiddieCorp is in its thirty-sixth year of providing high-quality children's programs and youth services to conventions, trade shows, and special events and has lots of experience in creating an engaging set of activities while providing appropriate oversight.

The cost for the childcare will be \$10 per hour, per child. Children must be registered for a minimum of two consecutive hours per child for each day registered.

Availability

Thursday, September 1: 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Friday, September 2: 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturday, September 3: 10 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. Sunday, September 4: 10 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. Monday, September 5: 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The advance registration deadline is August 18, 2022. While there will be registration on-site, there is no guarantee that space will be available when you want it. Advance registration allows KiddieCorp to schedule the right number of caregivers to maintain proper childcare ratios as required by law.

Additional babysitting services will not be available through the convention, but other commercial services, such as *UrbanSitter*, are available in Chicago for those who need them.




FIRE SALE!

Discuss, Debate, Decide: The WSFS Business Meeting

As a member of Chicon 8, you are a member of the World Science Fiction Society (WSFS). In addition to voting in the Hugos and Site Selection, as a member of WSFS, you have the opportunity to debate and vote on the rules of the organization, including *Hugo Award* categories, *Site Selection* processes, and the rules of how the debate on those topics happens (i.e., the rules for the WSFS Business Meeting).

The debate and discussion on these topics — Hugo Awards, Site Selection, and WSFS Business Meeting rules — occur at the Business Meeting (yes, the individuals at the meeting debate how the individuals at the meeting should debate). If you're an Attending member, you can be in the room where it happens and be part of that discussion!

The Business Meeting will occur from 10 a.m. CT to 1 p.m. CT Friday, September 2, to Monday, September 5, in Crystal B. If the agenda for any individual day is short enough, the meeting may end earlier. On Friday, we will determine the amount of time we will initially allot (it can always be amended) to each of the items on the agenda, handle resolutions to extend Hugo Award eligibility for some works, and hear committee reports. On Saturday, we'll dive into debate. Sunday is the Site Selection session, during which we will hear the results of the vote and a report from the winners, then return to debate on items on the agenda. Monday, if needed, is overflow.

Given the way debate occurs, there is no specific time at which any individual item of business will be discussed, just an order. That order is available in the *Business Meeting Agenda* (pdf).

PLEASE NOTE, unlike in previous years, printer copies of the agenda available at the convention will only contain items of New Business and Business Passed On with the accompanying commentary in an effort to be conscious of paper usage. The agenda currently on **www.Chicon.org** also contains Worldcon financial reports and committee reports. If you wish to have access to the full agenda in electronic form during the Business Meeting, we suggest saving a local copy on your device.

We encourage all interested members to arrive early to each session to sign in and schmooze and, if it is your first time, get situated and ask questions.

Site Selection

Chicon 8 will conduct the elections to select the site of the 2024 Worldcon and the 2023 North American Science Fiction Convention (NASFiC). To vote in either of these elections, you must be an attending or supporting member of Chicon 8. At the time of your vote, you will pay an additional amount called the Advance Supporting Membership fee, which is a supporting membership in the Worldcon or NASFiC, regardless of which site wins the election. This money goes to the winning Worldcon or NASFiC bid regardless of who wins or how you voted.
